Tasting Notes:

Deep purple in color and a thick texture that coats the sides of one's Burgundy glass with a lasting magenta hue. Ripe aromas and flavors of purple grapes, plums, and freshly plucked violets from soil burst from the glass.

The attack is ripe, with a bright black cherry note that keeps the wine fresh and lively on the palate. Partner with heartier cuisine like steaks, chops, or cheese plates with strongly flavored cheeses like a smoky blue.
